

## **Graduation Information—To Parents/Snake River Community Patrons**

The 71<sup>st</sup> Annual Commencement Exercises for the 2021 Graduating Class of Snake River High School will take place on Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 8pm in the Snake River High School Gymnasium. Graduation will begin at 8pm.

In person seating will take place in the SRHS Gym. The doors of the gym will open at 6pm for the public to be seated. Seats will not be “saved” prior to the doors being open to the public. Additional seating will be available in the SRHS Auditorium as overflow and where patrons can view the graduation as a live “online” transmission. We will also be transmitting the commencement ceremony over the internet.

Graduates will arrive at 7pm (or earlier) in the main commons. We would ask parents, family members, and friends to take as many pictures as possible PRIOR to the graduation ceremony. Students will line up in the Hall of Champions no later than 7:40pm. After the conclusion of the graduation ceremony, students will return their gowns to the office at which time, they will receive their diploma from Mrs. Anderton. Students will keep their cap and tassel. ALL gowns must be returned as they are the property of Herff-Jones.

### **Additional Information for Students and Parents:**

- The All Night Party will take place at Snake River High School beginning at 10pm. Information regarding the All Night Party is available from Celeste Martinez, Senior Class President or Sonia Martinez.
- For a student to be eligible to participate in Graduation exercises and to receive their diploma, all fees must be paid prior noon on Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. All school-owned texts and supplies must also be returned to the school at the time of student checkout.
- Graduation Practice will take place at 9:30am on Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>. It is imperative that all students who will be participating in the commencement exercises be at the practice.

### **DRESS REQUIREMENTS FOR THE GRADUATION CEREMONY FOR GRADUATES:**

**\*\*\*Male graduates will wear a dress shirt, tie, and dress slacks/pants. If the student does not have a dress shirt or tie, please visit with Mr. Buttars as the high school has some available for use.**

**\*\*\*Female graduates will wear an appropriate dress, skirt, and blouse, or dress slacks/dress pants.**

**\*\*\*All graduates will wear dress shoes (no flip flop style shoes, no athletic style shoes)**

**\*\*\*Cap and gowns must be worn to march. Students will not be allowed to have signs, other writing, stickers or any other markings on their caps or gowns.**

**\*\*\*Graduates will not be allowed to have with them during the ceremony: Cell phones, computer tablets, books, horns or other sound-producing devices, water-producing devices (squirt guns etc.), or any other items that would distract from the ceremony.**

The graduation commencement exercise is an activity that students, parents, and patrons will remember for a long time. It is a time for students and parents to reflect upon their twelve years of formal education, a time to consider the things that their parents and others have done to help them get to this point in their lives. Snake River High School has a reputation and history of making the graduation commencement exercise a great event; one with class and distinction.
